

Part-Time Teachers

6.1 Maximum Days at Work

The parties acknowledge that part-time teachers should be timetabled so that the number of days on which they are required to attend at work reflects their FTE as close as possible and does not exceed the following:

- A part-time teacher employed as 0.8 FTE may be assigned classes on 4 or 5 days per week.
- A part-time teacher employed as 0.6 or 0.7 FTE may be assigned classes on 3 or 4 days per week.
- A part-time teacher employed as 0.4 or 0.5 FTE may be assigned classes up to 3 days per week.
- A part-time teacher employed as 0.2 or 0.3 FTE may be assigned classes up to 2 days per week.

Principals are encouraged to consult with part – time teachers as early as possible concerning attendance requirements for the following year.
